	Official Transcripts
	• Submit official transcripts from all previously attended undergraduate and graduate institutions directly
	through SOPHAS/HAMPCAS.
	<ul> <li>Applicants must possess a minimum of four-year undergraduate degree (or its equivalent) with a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 preferred.</li> </ul>
	Evaluations/Recommendations
	<ul> <li>Enter contact information for your recommenders - a minimum of three (3) contacts are required.</li> </ul>
	Recommenders will be prompted electronically to complete an electronic evaluation as well as to submit a
	letter of recommendation.
	<ul> <li>At least one (1) of the evaluations must be from a faculty member who taught or supervised the applicant</li> </ul>
	Professional Resume/CV
	<ul> <li>Highlight professional experience, academic accomplishments, and other areas that showcase your overal competitiveness for the MHA program.</li> </ul>
	Personal Statement
	Why did you choose to pursue a Master of Health Administration (MHA)? Include specific reasons why the MHA (and healthcare) is the degree that best suits your career goals.

	International Applicants

- All applicants whose native language is <u>not</u> English will be asked to self-report one of these scores on the application: TOELF/IELTS English Proficiency Tests. This requirement can be waived for students who've earned a degree from an accredited US institution.
  - Minimum TOEFL score: 79. Minimum IELTS score: 6.5.
