	Graduate Entrance Exams - Admission decisions may be based in part on unofficial scores, but official scores are
	required prior to full admitted status.
	<ul> <li>GRE: Submit results directly to SOPHAS by using ETS code 4221.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Other acceptable exams: GMAT, MCAT</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Waivers: Test requirements are waived for applicants who have earned any of the following degrees: PhD,</li> <li>MD, DMD, DDS, PharmD, DVM, DO, DNP, or DSc from an accredited U.S. institution.</li> </ul>
	Official Transcripts
	<ul> <li>Submit official transcripts from all previously attended undergraduate and graduate institutions directly through SOPHAS.</li> </ul>
	SOPHAS Evaluations/Recommendations
	<ul> <li>A minimum of three (3) recommendations are loaded directly to SOPHAS by your recommenders. Enter</li> </ul>
	evaluator contact information in SOPHAS Express. Evaluators will be sent an evaluation questionnaire
	electronically; there is no requirement for a "letter of recommendation", just the SOPHAS evaluation
	questionnaire. At least one (1) of the evaluations must be completed by a faculty member who taught or
	supervised the applicant.
	Professional Resume/CV
	<ul> <li>Highlight professional experience, academic accomplishments, publications, and other areas that will showcase your overall competitiveness for the PhD HSR program.</li> </ul>
	Pre-requisites
	<ul> <li>Master's degree in a related field (e.g., public health, public administration and policy, health care administration, sociology, economics, or biostatistics) or an advanced clinical practice degree (e.g., PharmD, MD, PA, or NP degree). A minimum cumulative graduate GPA of 3.0 required.</li> </ul>
	International Applicants
	<ul> <li>All foreign transcripts must be evaluated by the World Education Services (<u>WES.org</u>) and submitted directly</li> </ul>
	to SOPHAS.
	<ul> <li>All applicants whose native language is <u>not</u> English will be asked to self-report one of these scores on the application: TOELF/IELTS English Proficiency Tests. Admission decisions may be based in part on unofficial</li> </ul>
	scores, but official scores are required prior to full admitted status. This requirement can be waived for
	students who've earned an undergraduate or graduate degree from an accredited US institution.
	<ul> <li>Minimum TOEFL score: 79. Minimum IELTS score: 6.5.</li> </ul>
