

PhD in Epidemiology & Biostatistics Admissions Checklist

- Online Application**
 - Visit [SOPHAS.org](https://sophas.org) and select “Apply”
- Graduate Entrance Exams** - Admission decisions may be based in part on unofficial scores, but official scores are required prior to full admitted status.
 - **GRE:** Submit results directly to SOPHAS by using **ETS code 4221**.
 - **Other acceptable exams:** GMAT, MCAT
 - **Waivers:** Test requirements are waived for applicants who have earned any of the following degrees: PhD, MD, DMD, DDS, PharmD, DVM, DO, DNP, or DSc from an accredited U.S. institution.
- Official Transcripts**
 - Submit official transcripts from all previously attended undergraduate and graduate institutions directly through SOPHAS.
 - Applicants must possess a minimum of four-year undergraduate degree (or its equivalent) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75, 3.0 preferred.
 - Applicants must possess a master’s degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Letters of Recommendation**
 - A minimum of three (3) letters are uploaded directly to SOPHAS by recommenders. At least one (1) of the letters must be from a faculty member who taught or supervised the applicant.
- Professional Resume/CV**
 - Highlight professional experience, academic accomplishments, publications, and other areas that will showcase your overall competitiveness for the PhD Epi-Bio program.
- Personal Statement**
 - Upload a personal statement that includes a description of the applicant’s research goals and how a joint degree in epidemiology and biostatistics provides the necessary training for career development.
 - *Note - Program faculty are actively engaged in research programs aligned with [University research priority areas](#). Applicants are encouraged to identify specific faculty research programs that would support their successful development into a productive independent researcher.
- Publication, Research Project, or other Scientific project**
 - At least one (1) mandatory
 - One additional allowed, no more than two total
- Pre-requisites**
 - Completion of Calculus I
 - Completion of Calculus II
- International Applicants**
 - All **foreign transcripts** must be evaluated by the World Education Services ([WES.org](https://wes.org)) and submitted directly to SOPHAS.
 - All applicants whose native language is not English will be asked to self-report one of these scores on the application: **TOELF/IELTS English Proficiency Tests**. Admission decisions may be based in part on unofficial scores, but official scores are required prior to full admitted status.
 - Minimum [TOEFL](#) score: 79. Minimum [IELTS](#) score: 6.5.
