Admissions to the MPH Program

Step 1: Apply via SOPHAS by April 1 for in-person or July 1 for online.

Step 2: If offered admission through SOPHAS, submit supplemental application to the UK Graduate School.

- Three Evaluations/Recommendations
- Resume/CV
- Writing Sample
