

Master of Science in Biostatistics – Fall 2026 Admissions Checklist

☐ Online Application – Apply via <u>SOPHAS</u>

- SOPHAS Fee \$150 for the first program you apply to (\$60 for each additional program).
- SOPHAS offers a Fee Assistance Program to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-served basis.

□ Official Transcripts

- Submit official transcripts from all previously attended undergraduate and graduate institutions directly through SOPHAS.
- Applicants must have a four-year undergraduate degree (or its equivalent) with a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 is preferred.
- All foreign transcripts must be evaluated by the World Education Services (WES.org) and submitted directly to SOPHAS.

□ SOPHAS Evaluations/Recommendations

- Enter contact information for your recommenders at least three (3) contacts are required.
- Recommenders will be prompted via email to complete an electronic evaluation and to submit a letter of recommendation to SOPHAS.
- We recommend that at least one (1) of the evaluations be from a faculty member who taught or supervised the applicant. In some cases, however, we understand that it is not possible.

□ Professional Resume/CV

- Upload resume or CV. Highlight professional experience, academic accomplishments, and other areas that will showcase your overall competitiveness for the MS program.
- ☐ **Personal Statement:** Upload a personal statement. Your statement should be approximately two pages in length, double-spaced, and cover the following:
 - 1. Describe your interest in biostatistics and how it relates to public health.
 - 2. Describe your professional and educational goals.
 - 3. Describe how the College of Public Health at the University of Kentucky will help you reach your professional and educational goals.
- ☐ English Language Proficiency: All applicants whose native language is not English, as defined by their country of residence, or who have not earned a degree from an accredited university in the United States, must submit English language proficiency scores from one of the following: TOEFL, IELTS, or DuoLingo.
 - Admission decisions may be based on unofficial scores, but official scores are required before enrollment in fall courses. Otherwise, admission may be revoked.
 - Minimum Score Required: <u>TOEFL</u> 79, <u>IELTS</u> 6.5, <u>DuoLingo</u> 115

Application Deadlines

- **★** INTERNATIONAL APPLICANT: **April 15, 2026**
- ★ DOMESTIC APPLICANT: Final application deadline June 1, 2026
- ★ If admitted, you must submit a supplemental application to the University of Kentucky no later than one month before the start of fall classes. Do not submit your supplemental application until you have been admitted to our MS program via SOPHAS. If admitted, you will receive emailed instructions and a link to the supplemental application.
